Competition Information

- Solo competitions will take place on Saturday October 1, 2022
- Register online at <https://celticheritage.org/competition>
- Entry deadline is September 10, 2022. No field entries will be permitted.
- Entry cost is \$8 per event
- Top 3 places in each event will receive a medal
- Aggregate winner in each grade with more than 5 competitors will receive a trophy. Players must play in all events in their grade to be eligible for the aggregate trophy

Competition Rules

- Competitors must wear appropriate highland dress. Highland dress is encouraged for competitors in Beginner grades, but is not required.
- Order of Play will be posted before the event. Competitors will follow the posted Order of Play, and may be disqualified at the discretion of the steward if not ready when called.
- Drummers must provide their own piper accompaniment
- All judges' decisions are final
